## INTER-OFFICE MEMORANDUM

REFERENCE: Our (PK-TM) telephone conversation, October 5, 1972, concerning memos to Whittington re ALCOA.

My 12-09-71 and 9-06-72

Hy 12-09-71 memo recommended that a public hearing be held in Port Lavaca on revision of MCO 00194, and that the hearing consider all pages of the proposed MCO as well as solid waste registration. Subsequently, I believe even more

Aside from the administrative requirements for a public hearing, e.g. previously unpermitted discharge (Outlet 003), increased flow, and new parameters not on the 1962 statutory permit, I feel there are other considerations which indicates

Prinarily, a hearing in Calhoun County would be a service to and in the public's best interest. The situation at ALCOA should be subjected to close public scrutiny. Wastes from ALCOA have degraded public waters in the area to such an extent that the TSDH had to close the bay for somatime to seafood harvest. The cause for this action was never explained in a public meeting, and the closing affected the livelihood of persons in the area. The mercury in the bay sediments still pose a threat to certain uses of the water. A public hearing obtained bring out action to be taken by ALCOA to prevent further degradation.

There has been unusual lethergy by ALCOA in instituting adequate waste control. Momerous staff conferences with ALCOA representatives have been relatively unproductive. It is felt the process of a public hearing in putting all facts bout ALCOA's environment program (or lack of it) out in plain view to all willing serve to accelerate ALCOA as needed.
